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How to Host A Kidney Transplant Connectors Program

PLAN

As the Host, we kindly request that you arrange a meeting space that can accommodate everyone. It should include a computer, monitor, and projector so our Kidney Transplant Connectors can share their presentation.

PROMOTE

Next, it's time to spread the word and invite participants to this incredible program. We'll provide you with an invitation that you can distribute via email, hardcopy, etc. We encourage you to aim for a minimum of ten participants for an in-person program, and three for virtual.

EXECUTE

If the event is in-person, our partner, VPR Patient Outreach Program (VPR POP) will provide educational handouts for all attendees. We ask that you have these available at the event.

On the day of the event, there's one thing that will make it that much more memorable: you! As the Host, you'll be there to assist and answer any questions related to your specific group:

- If you're hosting the event at a transplant center, you'll be the go-to person for questions specific to your transplant program and help answer any clinical questions.
- If you're a support group leader hosting the event, you'll be the expert on questions related to your group.

There's only one more thing: we'd love your help collecting attendees' surveys. If a Sanofi TNM is not involved in the program, you can scan and email the completed surveys to VPR POP. And, if Sanofi provides refreshments for the event, we will provide a sign-in sheet to be completed and returned.
